As Christmas rapidly approaches here are the arrangements for the next few weeks at nursery.

Throughout the coming weeks, the children will be making things for Christmas & will bring them home the last week of term. Here are some dates for your diaries.



Thursday 28^{th} November-Gala Theatre- 'Aladdin'- All children need to be at nursery at 8:30. The 15 hour groups need to be collected from nursery at approximately 1:00. The 30 hour groups will remain at nursery & need to be collected at 3:30. Children need to wear uniforms for this visit. Children do not need money sweets or drinks.




<u>Wednesday 4th December-</u> Jim Prior will be in nursery, videoing the children for the first part of the Christmas DVD. Orders for the DVD can be placed from this day (£10 each). Orders and payment must be made by 13th December.

<u>Wednesday 11^{th} December-Dress Rehearsals-</u>The children will perform their concerts during nursery sessions for pupils from Ropery Walk Primary School. Jim will video this for the Christmas DVD.



Thursday 12th December-Concerts- Children will perform their concerts on Thursday 12th December. Unfortunately due to limited space & high numbers of children we will have to restrict adult numbers viewing the concert to a <u>max of 2 per child</u>. Morning audience of children (Yellow morning group, White & groups) need to come for 10:00 performance. Afternoon audience of (Yellow afternoon group, Blue & Green groups) need to come for 1:45 performance. (Further details later.)





Monday 16^{th} December Christmas Craft Day 8:45-10:45 & 12:30-2:30 Please come along & join the children with their Christmas activities, story & snack time. Please can you complete the attached slip & return it to nursery a.s.a.p.

<u>Tuesday 17th December- Polar Express Day</u>- We are having a special 'Polar Express Day' in nursery where lots of special treats are planned (including hot chocolate, cookies and watching some of the film). We would like children to come to nursery in their <u>pyjamas & dressing gowns</u> (no slippers and no onesies) to make the day extra special. Please note the children still need to wear their



outdoor shoes and coats. Session times will be normal with no early pick up required.

Thursday 19th December- Christmas Parties.

There will be 2 parties, the 30 hour children will come on a morning 8:45-12:30 and go home after their lunch. The 15 hour children will come in on the afternoon at 12:30 for their party. Further details to follow.



<u>Friday 20th December- "Magic John" Entertains.</u> <u>All</u> children need to come to nursery at 8:45 for Magic John to entertain them. This will be followed by a giant picnic. The <u>15 hour children</u> need to be collected at $\underline{11:15}$ & the $\underline{30}$ hour children at $\underline{3:00}$.

Nursery Closes Friday 20^{th} December & reopens for the children on <u>Tuesday</u> 7^{th} <u>January 2020</u>.
